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


No dream left behind

The community we serve

Most of the children are first generation learners born to young parents who are unskilled laborers who migrate from rural poverty to cities in search of livelihood and settle in slums. As they struggle for basic survival, education is not a priority. Even if children are sent to school, it is very likely that a majority of them will drop out when they are teenagers. This results in girls becoming young mothers at the age of 13 or 14 and boys a burden on the family's meagre income.

SUKRUPA serves communities in and around R.T. Nagar which include Bhuvaneshwari Nagar, Kunthigrama, Shakthi Nagar, Hebbal, Cholanayakanahalli, Kankanagar and Gudadhahalli.

SUKRUPA is serving over 1000 families.

Mission


We enable every child with a good education, nurture them with life skills, bridge the gap between schooling and college and empower women socially and economically.

It has been an amazing journey as we persevere to create impact among first generation learners ensuring that they finish school and get into college. Children pursue their learning through creativity, get a strong foundation and are groomed to be college ready. It's a great delight to see most of our kids are studying in some of the best colleges in the city. As we continue to struggle for funds, we are growing from strength to strength with our passion, purpose and the continued trust of our supporters.

Growing towards creating greater impact we want more and more people to join hands in our journey. SUKRUPA started with forty children and today we have about 500 children in the school program and 50 in the college program. Especially the number of girls who are being impacted is increasing. We are looking for more mentors, volunteers and supporters to join hands in ensuring that no dream is left behind.





Our Programs

SuVidya: SUKRUPA Education Centre is a Stage board English medium school for 500 children from preschool to 10th grade. Children receive a quality education, nutritious lunch, life skills, creativity, sports and basic health care in a happy and safe environment.

SuKallp: Our after-school program guides teens in various life skills, providing them with tools to identify their interests and talents.

SuMargadarshak: College students receive scholarships, are guided academically and mentored to follow their goals to secure dream jobs and become independent.

SuJanavikas: Women are trained in skills that could evolve as a micro enterprise and empowered to run a thriving business, support their families and contribute to the economy at large.

It's been a great year for all of us at SUKRUPA. We are immensely happy that all our programs have created impact among the children, their families and the society. Through the school program SuVidya we were able to provide a creative learning space for the children with an array of activities.


Independence Day


CHANDANA

I’m a big fan of actor Vijay, I love his mass fighting scenes and dialogues. SUNDARAPOO


SuMargadarshak

Sundarapoo is pursuing B.Ed at Mount Carmel College. She is the first in her generation to get a good education. She completed her 10th Grade at SUKRUPA and did her 12th grade at Mount Carmel College. Her mother is a vegetable seller, who is the only bread winner of the family. Her father has been sick the last six months. Her younger sister Komati is doing her 1st year B.Com at Mount Carmel college. Her younger sister and brother are studying at SUKRUPA. Her father has been sick the last six months.

“I started my journey at SUKRUPA from my 2nd grade. It’s been eleven years at SUKRUPA and I cherish every moment of it. I have received so much love and care. I not just received financial support for my education but also mentoring and lots opportunities. At SuMargadarshak I receive scholarship for my education and mentorship to be life ready. I am part of the college NSS team. I completed my 1st semester with a first class distinction. I like reading books and listening to real life stories which are motivating. I want to become a good teacher and help children who can’t afford the means to receive a good education.”

Success so far

- Since 2014 SUKRUPA has had **82 students** complete 10th grade Board Exams most of them with 1st class marks especially girls
- **80 teenagers** have been part of a weeklong life changing program “Turning Point”
- One of the greatest achievement of SUKRUPA is all the teenage girls completing 10th, 12th and undergrad and secure dignified jobs to become independent and support their families against the norm of early teen marriage and motherhood when they are neither physically nor emotionally ready
- **30 first generation girls** are studying in some of the prestigious colleges in the city in PUC and U.G programs
- From the time of inception in 2002, **184 first generation students** have completed 10th and pursuing higher studies. **75 students** have completed 12th and working. **20 students** have completed graduation and secured jobs in reputed companies
- All the children at SUKRUPA communicate in English
- **52 students** are part of the Choir Group at Bangalore School of Music
- School dropout rate has reduced from **85% to 5%** in the communities that we serve
