




Most of the children are first generation learners born to young parents who are unskilled laborers who migrate from rural poverty to cities in search of livelihood and settle in slums. As they struggle for basic survival, education is not a priority. Even if children are sent to school, it is very likely that a majority of them will drop out when they are teenagers. This results in girls becoming young mothers at the age of 13 or 14 and boys a burden on the family's meagre income.

SUKRUPA serves communities in and around R.T. Nagar which include Bhuvaneshwari Nagar, Kunthigrama, Shakthi Nagar, Hebbal, Cholanayakanahalli, Kanakanagar and Gudadhahalli. SUKRUPA is serving over 1000 families.


OUN VISION

With a team of young motivated volunteers from SuMargadarshak – SUKRUPA's Scholarship and mentoring program for college students, we conducted UDAAN -Inspire to dream big at Dharmapuri in collaboration with Dharmapuri Resource Centre Society (DRCS) and Self-help group women for 150 children in Athakapadi Village Dharmapuri Tamil Nadu and in collaboration with ADHARSHA CLA Self Help Group women for 150 children in Malur Village Karnataka.

The elected members are enthusiastically performing their duties. They play a very important role in all the programs and activities conducted in the school, working together as a team to make school creative and fun for all their friends.


PARICHAYA OPEN DAY -OPEN MINDS - JAN 2020

SUKRUPA @ SALESFORCE TRAILHEADX 2019

SUKRUPA children build innovative prototypes developing creative solutions addressing the UN Sustainable Development Goals at Salesforce TrailheaDX India 2019 - Future Trailblazer Challenge. A week-long training program was conducted at SUKRUPA for 26 students from 8th and 9th Grade by Amritha University I AMMACHI Labs on robotics, maker skills and creative programming using Microsoft MakeCode and BBC Micro:bit.

The Kids Coding Camp at TrailheaDX India was a student friendly space for creativity, resourcefulness and a celebration of the Maker movement! During the two days at TrailheadX India, 4 teams of students picked the SDGs they were passionate about, defined the problems they would want to solve and prototyped solutions.

- 1. Automatic food dispensing truck that collects and dispenses left over food.
- 2. Automatic Irrigation system to detect soil moisture and irrigate crops
- 3. Automatic Incubator & Cradle to maintain body temperature of premature babies and rock them when they cry.
- 4. Automated lake cleaning mechanism that picks floating plastic.

SUKALLP


Our after-school program guides teens in various life skills, providing them with tools to identify their interests and talents.

CHALLENGES


In 2019 we started setting up Chitkala in R.T. Nagar. As SUKRUPA does not have good infrastructure, the thought was to provide a good foundation for Play School so that the 1st and 2nd grade students could also come and use the space

Our aim was to use this space to integrate the mainstream kids and children coming from economically backward communities bringing together children from different stratas of society so that they can learn together side by side. A Pre- School that has all the facilities to cater to all the different communities without any differences

We were so excited for the opening of Chitkala. We completed the infrastructure in 2018-19 and we were supposed to launch it in 2020. We built an infrastructure with metal sheets and framing, so that we could dismantle and rebuild in another location when we move to another space. We had the uniforms stitched for all the kids, the curriculum was prepared, the toys and play areas were designed and set up, we created a happy, colorful and welcoming environment.

Unfortunately on the onset of COVID-19 pandemic, we couldn't launch the program, this was very disappointing.



lot of things. All my subjects are new and interesting. I love art, I do sketches and painting. I want to become a civil engineer when I grow up.




SUCCESSION OF THE STATE OF THE

- Since 2014 SUKRUPA has had 82 students complete 10th grade Board Exams most of them with 1st class marks especially girls
- 80 teenagers have been part of a weeklong life changing program "Turning Point". One of the greatest achievement of SUKRUPA is all the teenage girls completing 10th, 12th and undergrad and secure dignified jobs to become independent and support their families against the norm of early teen marriage and motherhood when they are neither physically nor emotionally ready
- 30 first generation girls are studying in some of the prestigious colleges in the city in PUC and U.G programs
- From the time of inception in 2002, 184 first generation students have completed 10th and are pursuing higher studies. 75 students have completed 12th and are working. 20 students have completed graduation and secured jobs in reputed companies
- All the children at SUKRUPA communicate in English
- 52 students are part of the Choir Group at Bangalore School of Music

- School dropout rate has reduced from 85% to 5% in the communities that we serve
- UDAAN Inspire to Dream Big - SUKRUPA conducted a life skill leadership program for 300 teenagers in the villages of Dharmapuri Tamil Nadu and Malur Karnataka
- SUKRUPA children built innovative prototypes developing creative solutions addressing the UN Sustainable Development Goals at Salesforce TrailheaDX India 2019 -Future Trailblazer Challenge.


